ALL PEDESTRIANS ARE PROHIBITED

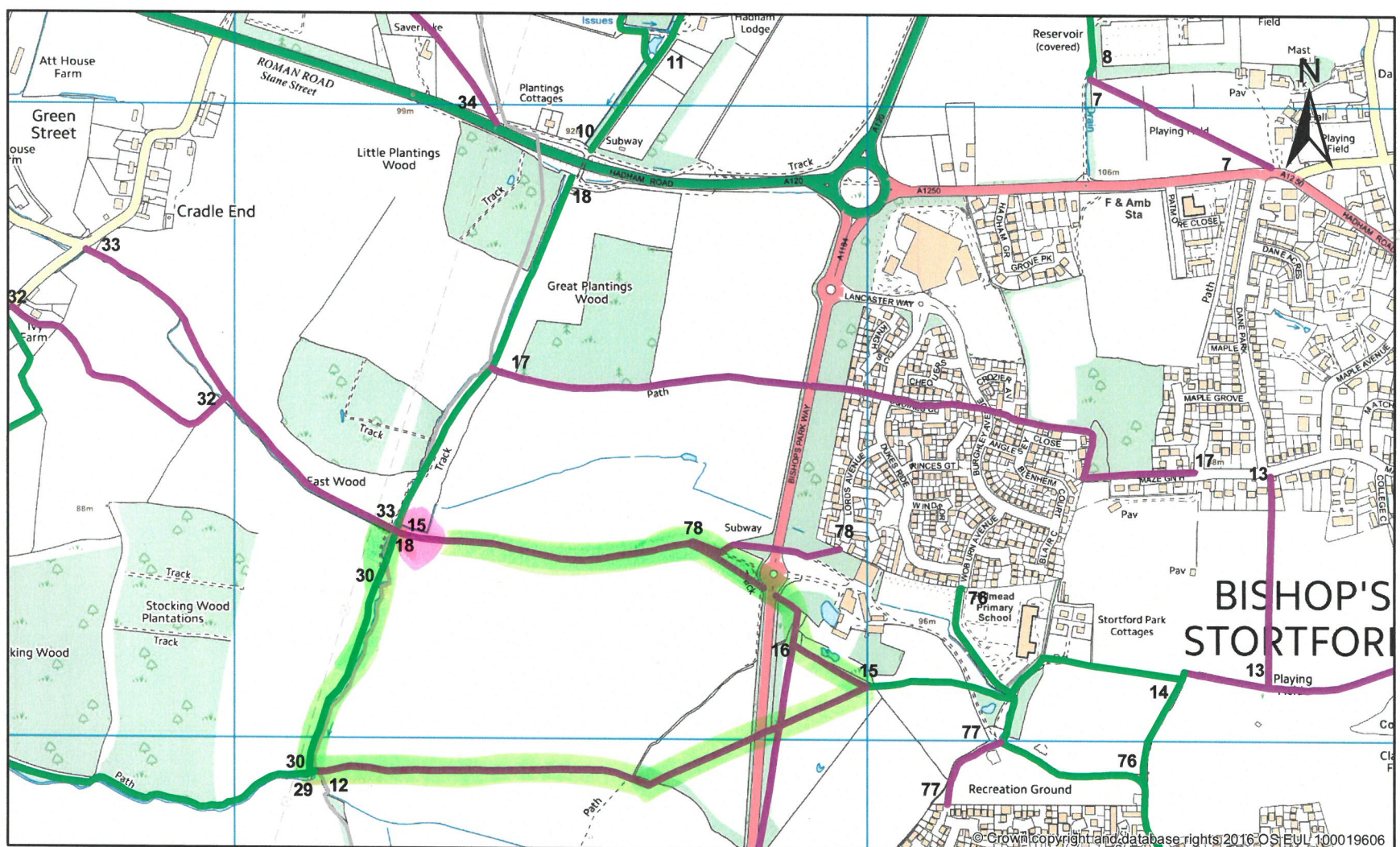

The section of Footpath will be closed on or after 2nd February 2018 for up to 6 months, when signs are in place.
