

TEMPORARY CLOSING OF BRIDLEWAYS LITTLE HADHAM 35, 36, FOOTPATHS LITTLE HADHAM 34, 57 AND 58

By an Order made by the Hertfordshire County Council

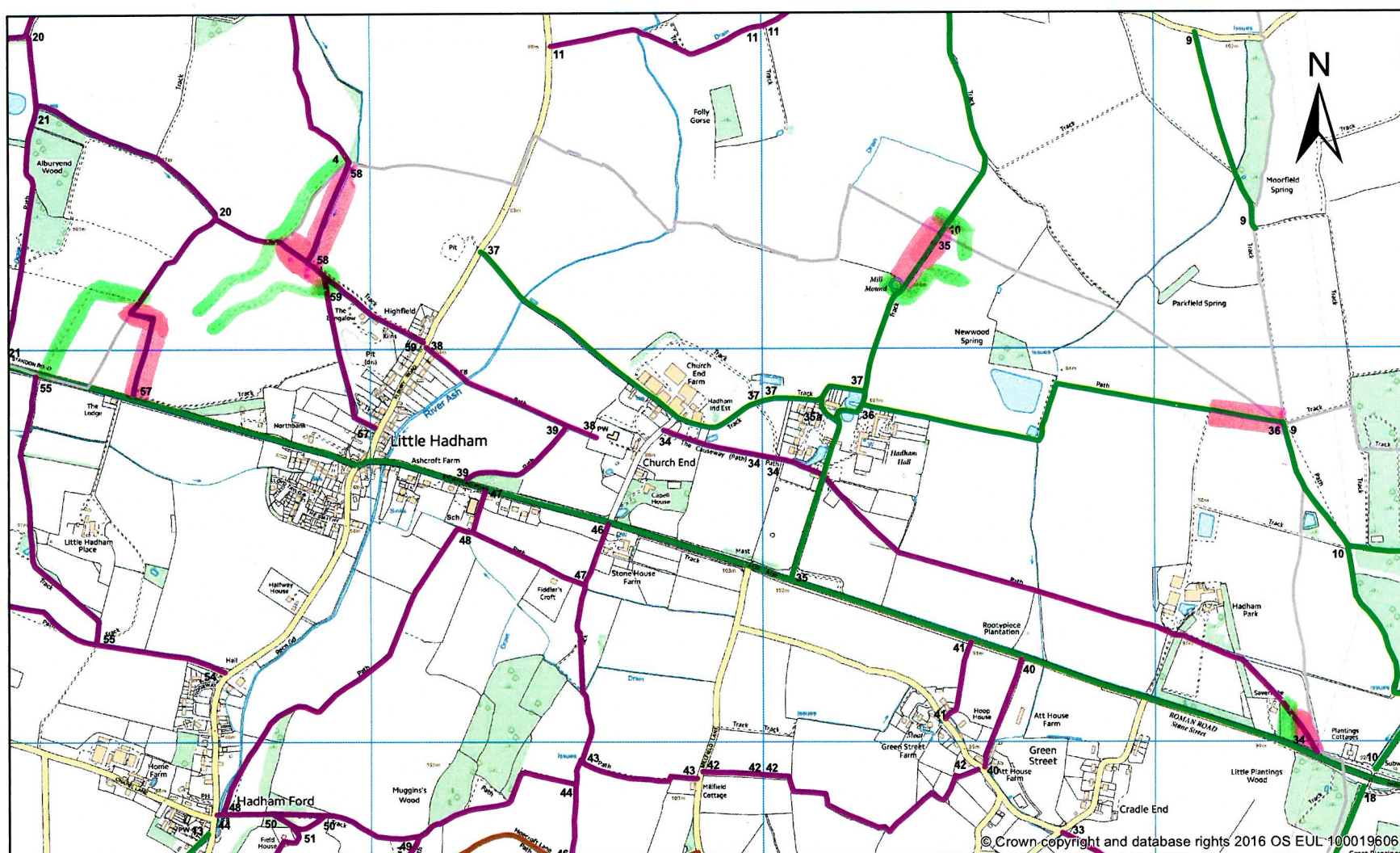
from using those lengths of Bridleways Little Hadham 35, 36, Footpaths Little Hadham 34, 57 and 58 [see plan below] the sections crossing the Little Hadham Bypass construction area. FP34 from A120 northwards, BR35 from Albury BR10 southwards, BR36 from Bishop's Stortford BR9 westwards, FP57 from A120 northwards, FP57 across new bypass at junction with FP58 and FP58 from FP57 to Albury FP4, for approximate distances of 130, 200, 280, 300, 150 and 280 metres.



The purpose of the Order is to enable Bypass construction works to take place.

The section of Bridleways and Footpaths will be closed on or after 8th July 2019 for up to 6 months, when signs are in place.
