Diversion Order 2021**

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Amy Wilkes and Jonathon Wilkes have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.


East Hertfordshire District Council and Much Hadham Parish Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

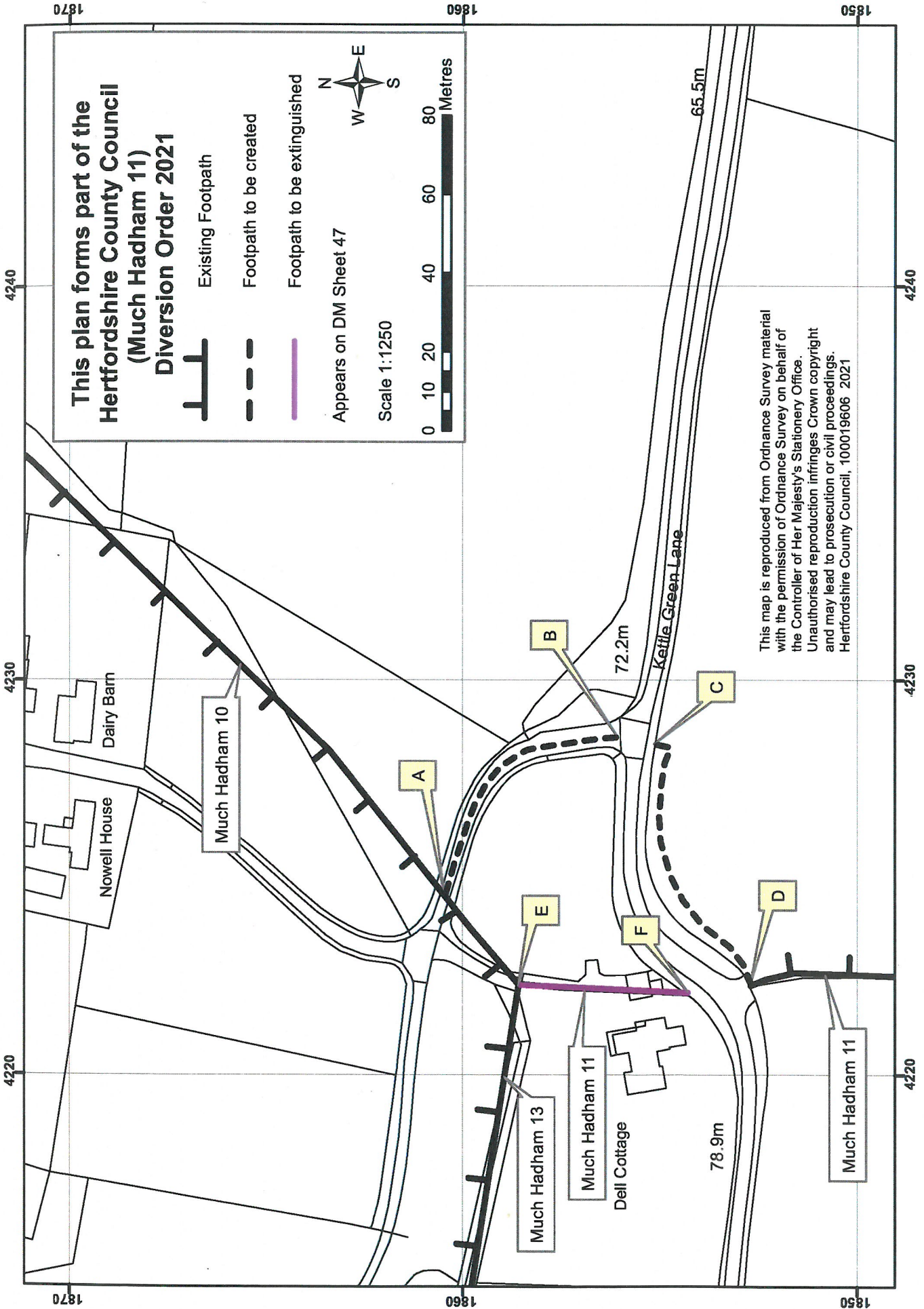
1. The public right of way over the land situate at Much Hadham and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order ("the Order Plan") and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall on the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Much Hadham described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Order Plan.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

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SCHEDULE

PART 1 DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The full width of that part of Much Hadham Footpath 11 from TL 4222 1858 (Point E on the Order Plan) continuing in a southerly direction for approximately 40 metres to TL 4222 1854 (Point F on the Order Plan).

PART 2 DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A Public Footpath (Much Hadham 11) from TL 4224 1860 (Point A on the Order Plan) running in a generally east south-east turning southerly direction along the access track for approximately 65 metres to a junction with Kettle Green Lane (public highway) at TL 4228 1856 (Point B on the Order Plan). Continuing south for approximately 5 metres from Kettle Green Lane at TL 4228 1855 (point C on the Order Plan) then in a generally westerly then south-westerly direction along the northern field boundary for approximately 70 metres to TL 4222 1852 (Point D on the Order Plan).

Width: 2.5 metres between TL 4224 1860 (Point A on the Order Plan) and TL 4228 1856 (Point B on the Order Plan) and between TL 4228 1855 (point C on the Order Plan) and TL 4222 1852 (Point D on the Order Plan).

PART 3 LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS
